PROCEDURE:

Interpretive listening activity (10 minutes)

Watch the video that introduces the scenic spots of Beijing, China.

Presentational speaking activity (5 minutes)

Students introduce the scenic spot of Beijing based on the picture they are given.

Interpersonal activity (15 minutes)

Students interview one another about the scenic spot that he/she visited in the past and describe it.

Presentational speaking activity (10 minutes)

Students report the interview results to the class.

3. Closure:

Presentational speaking activity (5 minutes)

Students introduce and describe the scenic spots of Beijing, China.

1. Warm up:

Presentational speaking activity (5 minutes)

Students describe the scenic spots of Beijing, China.

2. Practice:

Interpretive listening activity (5 minutes)

Watch the video that introduces the various means of transportation taken while travelling.

Presentational speaking activity (5 minutes)

Students describe the transportation means based on the picture they are given.

Interpersonal activity (15 minutes)

Students interview one another to learn about their opinions regarding the transportation means.

Presentational speaking activity (15 minutes)

Students report the interview results to the class and state the reasons why they like/dislike.

3. Closure:

Presentational speaking activity (5 minutes)

Students introduce the transportation means taken in travelling.

1. Warm up:

Presentational speaking activity (5 minutes)

Students introduce the scenic spots of Beijing and describe the transportation means taken in travelling.

2. Practice:

Interpretive listening activity (5 minutes)

Watch the pictures that introduce the scenic spots in Washington D.C., America.

Presentational speaking activity (10 minutes)

Students describe the scenic spots in Washington D.C. based on the pictures they are given.

Interpersonal activity (15 minutes)

Students describe their trip to their partner.

Presentational speaking activity (10 minutes)

Students report their partner's trip to the class.

3.Closure:

Presentational speaking activity (5 minutes)

Students describe the scenic spots in Washington D.C., America.


